

Saint Patrick's Parish Scholarships

FOUR (4) Scholarships valued at \$500.00 each.

Eligibility:

Grade XII Catholic students from St. Patrick's High School and Sir John Franklin High School who are eligible for Grade XII graduation in the school year for which the award is being given.

Students must attend a post-secondary educational institution within 15 months of graduation.

A cheque in the amount of the scholarship will be given to the successful students upon confirmation of attendance at a post-secondary educational institution.

Application Requirements:

1. Students must apply for the scholarship on or before May 15th of the school year
2. Students must list on their application form their contribution to the St. Patrick's Parish community in Yellowknife during their high school years. This can include, but is not limited to: attendance at Mass and other Church celebrations; participation in church ministries; any participation in church functions or celebrations as part of school life; assist with the Flea Market. In identifying the ways you contributed to the Parish Community, students should indicate, not only the how, but also when (Grade 10, 11, 12) and the frequency and duration of their contribution. Students may attach a second sheet to the application form if there is not sufficient space to list their contributions.
3. Students must submit a 500-word essay (approximately 3 pages). The essay should be double spaced and typed if possible. The cover page must include the Students Name, School, Title of Essay, and Date the essay is submitted to the office with the application form.

The essay must be the original work of the student submitting it.

Essay topics for the student to choose from are:

- i) My Catholic Identity
- ii) The Role of the Catholic Church in My Life... Yesterday, Today, and Tomorrow

- iii) Tomorrow's Catholic Youth Ministry – What it Could Be!
- iv) The Value of Active Participation in a Catholic Parish Community
- v) The Interacting Relationship of Parents, Children and the Parish/Church
